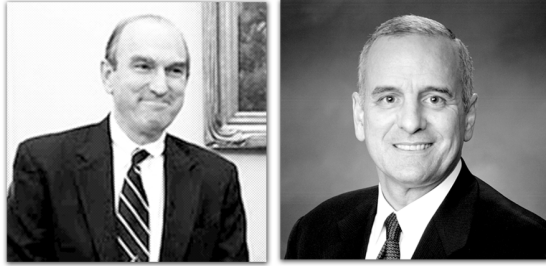

**AIPAC**, or the **American Israel Public Affairs Committee**, describes itself as the most important organization affecting the U.S. relationship with Israel. AIPAC has one objective: strengthening American support for Israel. Because our politicians are fearful of confronting AIPAC, they give in to AIPAC's demands no matter what the impact on the U.S. or the Mideast might be, enabling Israel to commit flagrant human rights abuses and violations of international law. AIPAC supports endless conflict in the Middle East by lobbying for billions of dollars in U.S. military aid to Israel and continued occupation of Palestinian land. AIPAC works to insure that Israel is provided with U.S. military aid and weapons at the cost of more than \$3 billion each year.

**Elliot Abrams**, AIPAC's featured speaker, was one of the most odious participants in a particularly shameful chapter of U.S. history. As Ronald Reagan's assistant secretary of state for Inter-American affairs, Abrams supervised U.S. policy in Latin America, which resulted in the murder of countless thousands of innocent civilians throughout Central America, killed at the hands of American-trained death squads and military units - more than 200,000 civilians murdered in Guatemala alone. Many more were tortured and raped by U.S. proxies and CIA operatives - all this with the connivance of Elliot Abrams, who lied to Congress about the atrocities. Abrams was convicted of perjury and later pardoned by George H.W. Bush. Elliot Abrams was also one of the original signatories to the Project for a New American Century, which openly advocated for total global military domination. Under George W. Bush, Abrams held positions in the National Security Council where he oversaw Bush's disastrous and unjust Mideast policies.
